



## 关于 MSC 地中海邮轮安全检查及乘客禁止携带物品的说明

尊敬的 MSC 地中海邮轮乘客：

感谢您选择搭乘美丽的地中海邮轮。登上我们的邮轮，您将感受到传统地中海式的热情问候。您可以尽情体验地中海邮轮真挚且人性化的服务理念，同时充分领略世界各地的文化和风景。为了您和您的家人能顺利圆满完成本次旅程，我们善意地提醒您，在出发前，请务必阅读如下内容，并严格遵守。

1. 请在出发前收取并阅读《地中海邮轮标准承运条款》，您可通过预定代理、旅行社或地中海邮轮公司获得该文件。
2. 《地中海邮轮标准承运条款》中第 19 条列明乘客责任，船长或管理人员有权基于安全、安保或其他合法理由对船上的乘客的随身行李进行检查。
3. 为了全体乘客的安全，安全部门将在登船港口及沿途港口对登船、离船人员进行安全检查。安全检查通过 X 光设备和金属探测器等进行。
4. 请配合地中海邮轮员工的安检工作，使整个流程顺利高效。乘客应在登船港口按程序交付托运行李，符合规定的托运行李将在登船后由专员送至客舱门口，被送至门口的托运行李表明已经检查完毕。
5. 地中海邮轮在此告知乘客，严禁在随身行李或托运行李中携带如下物品登船。如经发现，此类物品一律将被船方没收，无法退还；此类物品提示将出现在登船港口及邮轮安全检查的步骤中（如附件）



6. 在邮轮行程中，如乘客在岸上游览时购买如上类型物品，在返回邮轮时也将无法携带登船。

- 1) 非法毒品及非法物品：麻醉品用具；所有非法的毒品和物品
- 2) 刀具及利器：所有刀刃包括或超过 4 英寸（10 厘米）的刀具，无论形状大小。包括各种隐藏在皮带扣，拐杖等日常用品内的具有潜在威胁的利器；
- 3) 枪支弹药及武器：枪支，弹药及武器步枪，猎枪，手枪，左轮手枪，气弹枪，仿真枪等等；
- 4) 武术及自卫器械
- 5) 爆炸物品：爆破物、炸药、烟火、构成炸弹的成分等；
- 6) 腐蚀性化学制品及其他危险物品：氯、漂白剂、喷漆、催泪瓦斯、变压器、插线板/魔方插座、灭火器、小型储气瓶、高频率对讲机、蓄电池（电动轮椅电池除外）、其他压力容器等；
- 7) 五金工具：所有长度超过 17 厘米的工具（如扳手钳子螺丝刀等）；
- 8) 易燃物及发热物：所有易引起明火或发热的物品都是严令禁止的，包括但不限于以下物品：蜡烛、线香、电熨斗、旅行喷汽熨斗、电热锅、电磁炉、电热水壶、烧水壶、茶杯加热器、暖手宝、喷雾剂（除个人化妆用品外），燃料（包括烹饪燃料和其他任何易燃液体）、多插头插座/电源板及其延长线，以及其他带有加热部件的器具；
- 9) 运动器材：棒球及棒球棍、滑板、冲浪板、自行车、曲棍球棍、高尔夫球杆等；



10) 食品，水果，酒水：任何未经加工或者需要冷冻的食品、开封并部分吃过的食物、这种食物包括三明治、寿司、汉堡包、糕点、蛋糕等；各类水果；各种酒类（若宾客携带相关物品登轮，宾客的物品在邮轮行程中将由船方代为保存并在离船时归还）；












11) 遥控设备：任何遥控或自动飞行装置的玩具、无人机、平衡车等；危险物品：包括枪支、爆炸物品、易燃易爆物品、腐蚀性物品、毒害物、放射性物品，所有刀具（刀片、匕首、瑞士军刀、剪刀）等。

\*特别申明：MSC 地中海邮轮有权利认定有可能威胁宾客和船员的生命安全或邮轮航行安全的任何其他物品。如未遵守上述安全规定，我们有权拒绝让您登船。
